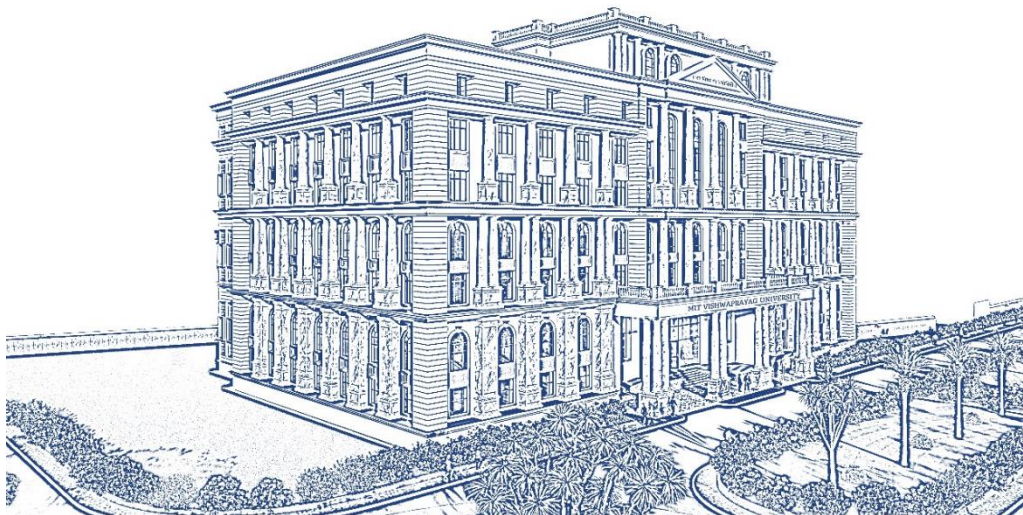

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

Indian Candidates

- Notifications & advertisements about the application forms & important dates will be published on the MIT-VPU website.
- Application forms can be filled online at the MIT-VPU official website by paying the application fee for entrance examination of Rs 750/- for BBA & BCA , Rs 1000/- for B.Tech, MBA & MCA, & Rs 1,500/- for B.Des (non-refundable) through online mode. (Net Banking/Debit Card/Credit Card/UPI)
- Candidates will be selected either through National Level Entrance Tests / Maharashtra CET/ PERA-CET/MIT-VPU CET (Entrance Test) conducted online / offline across the country.
- **Admissions will be purely based on the ranks** secured in All National Level Entrance Tests / Maharashtra CET/ PERA-CET/MIT-VPU CET mentioned in respective eligibility criteria of the programmes.
- **Candidates will be shortlisted based on their rank/score & Personal Interaction** (if applicable) as per the Eligibility Criteria.
- Eligible candidates will be allocated seats based on their scores in the respective examinations and verification of the relevant documents. The production of original documents for verification shall be mandatory.

International Candidates

- Admissions will be based on marks or grades obtained in the qualifying exams (As per Eligibility) & seats availability. (Subject to the verification of eligibility by the equivalence committee of the university.) All admissions will be provisional subject to verification of eligibility as per the norms of the University.

RESERVATION IN ADMISSIONS

Reservation Policy as prescribed by the Government of Maharashtra from time to time will be applicable for the admissions.

A. Territorial Reservation:

As per Section 34 (4) of the MIT Vishwaprayag University Act 2023 “Out of total approved intake capacity, **forty percent** of the seats shall be reserved for the students domiciled in the State of Maharashtra.

Note: 40% seats are reserved for Maharashtra that means 60% seats are open. Those seats can be allotted to anyone including Maharashtra Candidates and these are not reserved for OMS.

Documents required to claim Territorial Reservation

Domicile Certificate / Birth Certificate / Nationality Certificate

B. Social or Vertical Reservation:

The Reservations given below shall be applicable only to the candidates belonging to the State of Maharashtra. Candidates from outside the Maharashtra State, even if belong to reserved category, as per the reservation policy of the respective States, still for the admission purposes in MIT Vishwaprayag University, Solapur those candidates will be treated as open candidates.

(i) Reservation for EWS Candidate: As per the provisions in Government Resolution No. 4019/- 31/16, dated 12th February 2019, 10% seats shall be reserved for Economically Weaker Section (EWS) candidates. These 10% seats shall be over & above the sanctioned intake for the respective course.

(ii) Concession in fee/ Scholarship to the 10% of students belonging to Economically Weaker Section Admitted in AY 2024-25 (As per (i) above). As per the provision of Government of Maharashtra GR Misc-2022/pk91/vishs-4, dt 22.06.2023, 50% concession/scholarship in total fee will be provided to 10% (ten percent) students as per merit, belonging to Economically weaker section as per Government Norms.

C. Horizontal Reservation:

Apart from the above reservations, there will be parallel reservations for Son/Daughter of Defence Service Personnel, Disable candidates and women candidates.

i. **Five percent** seats of the total sanctioned intake of an institute shall be reserved for children of ex-service personnel and active service personnel who are domiciled in Maharashtra and of active service personnel, who are not domiciled in Maharashtra but are transferred to Maharashtra. Provided that such candidate should have appeared and passed the HSC Examination from the School situated in the State of Maharashtra.

ii. **Five percent** seats of the total Seats for Maharashtra candidates per course shall be reserved for candidates with disability (minimum 40% benchmark disability). The candidates claiming reservation under this category shall submit the certificates from the authority competent for issuing such certificate which clearly states that the extent of disability is not less than 40% and the disability is permanent in nature.

iii. **Thirty percent** of the total sanctioned intake of the program shall be reserved for women candidates. This reservation, however, being horizontal reservation, thirty percent seats will be reserved within the categories. For example, if there are 100 seats available for admission. Then 13 seats will be available for Scheduled caste and 7 seats for Scheduled Tribe and so on. Out of these 13 and 7 seats, 30 percent seats i.e. 4 and 2 will be available for women of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribe, respectively. Thus, reservation for women will be 30 percent within the category.

PAYMENT OF FEES AND REFUND POLICY

(Academic Year 2024-25)

1. Payment of Fees:

a. Payment of Fees at the time of admission:

Registration by the student at the beginning of each semester is compulsory. Students must pay the full fees of the semester at the time of admission or during extended time, not more than 10 days, given by the concerned Head, then only they will be permitted to register for the semester and attend the classes.

b. Payment of fees of second and subsequent semesters:

Students must pay the full fees of the semester before the commencement of the semester or during extended time, not more than 10 days, given by the concerned Head, then only they will be permitted to register for the semester and attend the classes.

2. Late Fees:

If any student pays the fees after the due date/s, then.

- a. If paid within 30 days after the due date, late fee of ₹ 50.00 per day.
- b. If paid after 30th but before 60th day after the due date, late fee ₹ 100.00 per day after 30th day.
- c. If the fee is **not paid** even after the 60th day, then the name of the student shall be struck off from the records of the Institute and University.
- d. In case, the name of the student is struck off from the records of the Institute and University, then Transfer Certificates or recommendations for admission to the other Institutes / colleges will not be issued to the student or parent.

3. CANCELLATION OF ADMISSION & REFUND OF FEE POLICY

MIT-VPU will consider any request for cancellation/withdrawal of admission from students only if such request is made by the regulations prescribed by the University. The regulations include the procedure for cancellation/withdrawal of admission as well as the rules for refunds.

*A processing fee of Rs. 1000/- shall be charged

Conditions:

- Request for cancellation of admissions must be sent through the registered email to the email id mentioned in the offer guide.
- Refund will be made as per the university norms.
- Refund will be made only after the submission of proof of fee paid, Provisional Seat Allotment Letter, and No Dues Certificate from the concerned department. The refund will be made through an account transfer to the account number mentioned in the withdrawal request. Hence, the correct bank account details must be provided in the withdrawal request.
- Refund would be considered only in respect of the Programme Fee paid by the applicant. No refund shall be allowed in respect of Application Fees for entrance examination and any other levies.
- In case the student fails to fulfil the eligibility criterion, then the student must communicate the same to the University within 10 days from the date of declaration of the result from the concerned Board/University. If the student fails to do that and seat thus vacant is filled, then in such cases the university would refund the Fee Paid after deducting Rs.10,000/-, else no refund shall be admissible.

Important Notes:

- All refunds shall be remitted only to the bank account of the student/parent as per the NEFT details furnished and shall be made within 20 working days from the date of approval of the cancellation/withdrawal.

- All disputes related to the refund of fees will be subject to Pune jurisdiction only.

4. Bank Charges:

- All bank charges pertaining to inward remittance of the fees, if any, shall be debited to students' accounts.
- In the event of cheque / draft return, a sum of ₹ 1000.00 besides the bank charges shall be debited to the student's account.

SCHOLARSHIPS

MIT-VPU offers financial assistance and scholarships to its meritorious students based on their academic performance in proposed National level/State Level entrance exams for the academic year 2024-25.

The categories of Merit Scholarships are detailed below.

A. MITVPU Merit Scholarship-I: This scholarship provides a 100% tuition fee waiver for the **first year** of the program upto 3% of the total students' intake, **provided the candidate secures;**

- 90 percentile and above for B Tech in JEE or MHT-CET
- 90% and above or equivalent for BBA, BCA and B.Sc programs in 12th Scores (any stream).
- 90 percentile and above for B. Des in NID, UCEED, CEED, DAT & PERA CET.
- 90 percentile and above for B Pharm in MHT-CET.
- 80% and above in MHTCET / CAT / XAT 90% and above in MAT for MBA Program
- 80% and above in MHT-CET for MCA program MHT- CET.

(The university may award scholarships in subsequent years of the program based on the academic performance and other criteria as decided by the university.)

B. MIT-VPU Merit Scholarship-II: This scholarship provides a 50% fee waiver for the **first year** of the program and is applicable for 8% of the total students' intake, **provided the candidate secures**

- 80 percentile and above for B Tech in JEE or MHT-CET
- 80% and above or equivalent for BBA, BCA and B.Sc programs in 12th Scores (any stream).
- 80 percentile and above for B. Des in NID, UCEED, CEED, DAT & PERA CET.
- 80 percentile and above for B Pharm in MHT-CET.
- 75% and above in MHTCET / CAT / XAT 80% and above in MAT for MBA Program
- 75% and above in MHT-CET for MCA program **MHT- CET.**

(The university may award scholarships in subsequent years of the program based on the academic performance and other criteria as decided by the university.)

C. MIT-VPU Merit Scholarship-III: This scholarship provides a 25% fee waiver for the **first year** of the program and is applicable for 12% of the total students' intake.

- 75 percentile and above for B Tech in JEE or MHT-CET
- 75% and above or equivalent for BBA, BCA and B.Sc programs in 12th Scores (any stream).
- 75 percentile and above for B. Des in NID, UCEED, CEED, DAT & PERA CET.
- 75 percentile and above for B Pharm in MHT-CET.
- 70% and above in MHTCET / CAT / XAT 75% and above in MAT for MBA Program
- 70% and above in MHT-CET for MCA program **MHT- CET.**

(The university may award scholarships in subsequent years of the program based on the academic performance and other criteria as decided by the university.)

D. Fee Waiver to Elite Sportsperson: This fee waiver is awarded to deserving sports persons based on their participation/winning the prizes at Nationally/Internationally recognized sports competitions/events. Any candidate who participates/wins a medal at west zone inter-university, all India inter-university, national or international level, while representing MIT-VPU or playing for any Govt. sponsored/ Govt. recognized official sports organization [IOA, BCCI, etc.]; in any nationally/ internationally recognized sporting event; in individual or team sports; would be eligible for the following waiver for the remaining period of the programme, only if he/she participates and wins a medal on the National / International Level.

If the student has secured a top 5 ranking position in a tournament (Badminton, Chess, Table Tennis, Shooting, Archery etc.) conducted by or affiliated with a recognized govt. sponsored/Govt. official sports organization or federation at National or International level, then he/she will be eligible for the participation scholarship.

As per the Academic calendar, (i.e. from 1st August – 31st July), if a student has secured a medal in his 12th std. then he/she can apply for the scholarship, provided all the criteria is met, in the 1st year itself. Securing a medal in 1st year, will result in a scholarship being awarded in the 2nd year and so on. In case, a student is in the last academic year, then he/she can apply for a reimbursement in the same academic year only.

Note: An individual or team winning at West Zone, All India level, National or International level would be eligible for any one concession (whichever is higher).

FEE CONCESSIONS

1. Wards of MIT-VPU/ MAEER's Staff Members:

- Applicable to the wards of the faculty/staff members who are in continuous employment at any institute /college/ University under MAEER for 3 continuous years of service at the time of Admission.
- If the faculty/ staff leaves the organization due to termination/resignation or any other reason, the applicable fees for that year shall be payable in full. The scholarship won't be applicable.
- For claiming this scholarship, the student must obtain a minimum of 60% marks in the qualifying examination.
- The amount of the scholarship is based on the gross salary of the employee. The scholarship as a percentage of fees is given below:

2. Defence:

- Wards of personnel working in or retired from the Defence Services/ Para-military services are eligible for a concessions in their first year. The fee concession would be 25% for the wards of Non- Commissioned Officers (NCO's), 15% for the wards of Junior Commissioned Officers (JCO's) & 10% for the wards of Senior Commissioned Officers.

3. Physically Challenged:

- Students with 40% & higher disability will be given concessions amounting to 40% of fees depending upon disability. The disability must be certified by a medical authority specified by the government. UGC has approved a 3% reservation in admission for differently abled students.

4. Jammu & Kashmir Migrant:

- Only one seat per division of 60 will be allotted based on merit to a candidate eligible for seeking admission under J & K migrant quota, which would be over & above the regular approved intake for the said program.
- Scholarship /Fee Concession equal to 50% amount of the fee will be granted for the entire program duration. It will be subject to good behavior, discipline & passing in university examinations.
- These students would not be eligible for any other scholarship other than those covered under the Rank holder or Elite sportsman Scholarship.

Other Concession: (% will be decided by the management)

Sibling Concession: The scholarship will be applied on the tuition fees of the sibling, (if any sibling of enrolled student is willing to enroll).

Alumni Concession: The alumni scholarship is applicable to candidates who have successfully completed a course at our institutes (any institute under MAEER's).

Diploma Holders / B.Sc Computer Science:

Any student who has completed 3 years Diploma or B.Sc computer science will get the fees wavier if he or she enrolls in 1st year B.Tech.
